I teach core art classes , upper level art classes, graduate classes plus advanced and graduate independent study in art studio and art history.

Studio format classes are required to meet for 96 hours each during a regular semester.

I average 10 independent study students per regular semester in 8 separate areas: oil painting, watercolor, mixed media, computer art, curriculum development, drawing, sculpture/ installation art, & exhibition. Conducted a Graduate and Advanced Critique class twice a month, for all art studio students to participate in.
