COURSE DESCRIPTION: This class will provide one on one instruction in scenic design and drafting, along with instruction in CADD using Vectorworks

COURSE GOALS: The student will develop the skills to design scenery for one Sul Ross production as well as gain a moderate understanding of how to use Vectorworks to facilitate the process of designing a drafting for the stage.

DAYS AND HOURS: Class will meet Wednesdays from 11:00-12:00, or at the discretion of the instructor.

SCOPE OF COURSE: The student will be graded on the quality of the design based on the following criteria:

- How well the design serves the play
- How well the design matches the requirements of the director
- The ease of communicating the designers ideas through the drafting
- How well the designer works with the technical director to create the set.

LAB HOURS: The student will be expected to work independently on their scene design for the production chosen outside of normal class meeting time
