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COURSE DESCRIPTION: An opportunity to play an instrument in the orchestra for the summer musical. Enrollment is by audition with the instructor.

COURSE OBJECTIVES (EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES):

Students will:

1. receive an introduction to musical theater;
2. practice and master an instrumental part for the summer musical;
3. listen and play cooperatively in the orchestra;
4. evaluate their playing experience;
5. participate in a cross-campus experience for majors and non-majors interested in musical theater.

GRADING SCALE:

Your grade is a pass/fail (A or F). Attending all orchestra rehearsals and performances will result in an automatic A. Failure to attend all orchestra rehearsals and performances will result in an automatic F, regardless of hours accrued.
