**GENERAL LEARNING OUTCOMES:**

After completing this course and the paired MATH 0300 course, the student should be able to demonstrate competency in the following:

- (1) Demonstrate skills with fractions and decimals;
- (2) Verify equivalent fractions, decimals, and percentages; apply skills to analyzing percentages;
- (3) Generalize algebraic operations on real numbers and apply properties of real numbers;
- (4) Verify equivalent expressions and generalize to algebraic operations;
- (5) Apply skills and properties for solving equations and practical problems;
- (6) Apply linear graphing techniques
- (7) Apply basic geometric formulas; generalize to practical geometric concepts.

**COURSE REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1) The student must attend all six hours of the review.
- 2) The student must take the common course final for this course.

**METHOD OF EVALUATION:**

- 1) Students who attend the review and pass the common course final will earn a grade of "P."
- 2) Students who attend the review, take the common course final, but who do not pass the course, will earn a grade of "PR."
- 3) Students who do not attend the review and/or do not take the common course final will earn a grade of "F."
