- The meeting was called to order by Dr. Eric Busby at 3:30 pm with 50 in attendance and 8 counted toward quorum.
- Minutes: There was a motion made by Dr. Jessica Velasco and seconded by Dr. Juliana Dean to accept the April 2024 minutes as presented. The motion passed.
