METHOD OF EVALUATION:

- 1) Students who attend the review and pass the common course final will earn a grade of "P."
- 2) Students who attend the review, take the common course final, but who do not pass the course, will earn a grade of "PR."
- 3) Students who do not attend the review and/or do not take the common course final will earn a grade of "F."
