While **68%** of students **USED PERSONAL SAVINGS** and **71%** **USED CURRENT WAGES TO PAY FOR SCHOOL,**



ONLY 2% ARE ABLE TO SOLELY RELY ON THIS SELF-HELP.

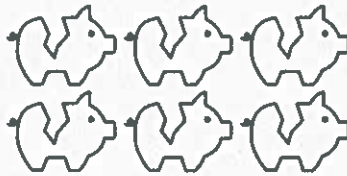
61% of students would have **TROUBLE GETTING \$500 IN CASH OR CREDIT** in an emergency.



10% of students **WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO GET THAT AMOUNT FROM ANY RESOURCE.**



79% of students **WORRY ABOUT HAVING ENOUGH MONEY** to pay for school.



27% of students **RAN OUT OF MONEY 6 OR MORE TIMES** in the past year.

54% of students **REPORTED BEING HOUSING INSECURE.**



20% of students had **VERY LOW FOOD SECURITY.**



49% of students indicated **EXPERIENCING GENERALIZED ANXIETY DISORDER.**



82% of students **PAY THEIR CREDIT CARD ON TIME EACH MONTH,**



but **ONLY 26%** **PAY THE FULL BALANCE.**



61% of students **WOULD USE FINANCIAL SUPPORT SERVICES IF OFFERED BY THEIR SCHOOL.**



22% of students **DON'T KNOW WHERE TO FIND FINANCIAL ADVICE.**
