

SRSU (ALP + RGC) Campus Environment Survey

Spring 2021 *June 1st, 2021*

Purpose of Survey: The SRSU Campus environment survey is a university-wide survey with the objective to measure important aspects of living and working within the university. The annual survey asks university internal stakeholders (students, faculty, and administrators) to participate in an anonymized survey responding to questions regarding work-life balance, discrimination/fair treatment, communication, organization/leadership, and other factors influencing living, working, and learning environments. The survey was launched on April 19th, 2021 and closed on May 16th, 2021. All survey links were distributed via anonymous link distribution which automatically anonymities all identifier information pertaining to a given respondent.


Frequency of Survey Implementation: Once per Year (Spring)

Number of Participants: 422 respondents, response rate of 17.7%




Q1 - What is your primary campus? (all)


Q2 - What is your primary affiliation to SRSU? (all)


Q3 - With which college are you primarily associated? (all)


Q4 - Gender? (all)






Q7 - Student enrollment status. (student)




Q10 - I have a clear understanding of my degree plan. (student)




Q11 - How do you typically receive class instructions? (student)

Q12 - I have access to the following support services (choose all that apply). (student)








Q16 - Is it likely you will be attending SRSU one year from now? (student)


Q17 - Employment status (Faculty/Staff)








Q20 - How long do you anticipate working at SRSU? (faculty/staff)


Q21 - I am aware of professional development opportunities at SRSU which meet my career and work needs. (faculty/staff)


Q22 - I have a clear understanding of my career and/or path to promotion at SRSU. (faculty/staff)

Q23 - Part V - Perceptions of University Commitments (Leadership, Service and Communication) Please indicate your level of agreement/disagreement to the following statements: (all)








