Spring 2022

April 26, 2022

Purpose of Survey: The SRSU Campus environment survey is a university-wide survey with the objective to measure important aspects of living and working within the university. The annual survey asks university internal stakeholders (students, faculty, and administrators) to participate in an anonymized survey responding to questions regarding work-life balance, discrimination/fair treatment, communication, organization/leadership, and other factors influencing living, working, and learning environments. The survey was launched on April 8th, 2022 and closed on April 22nd, 2022. All survey links were distributed via anonymous link distribution which automatically anonymities all identifier information pertaining to a given respondent.

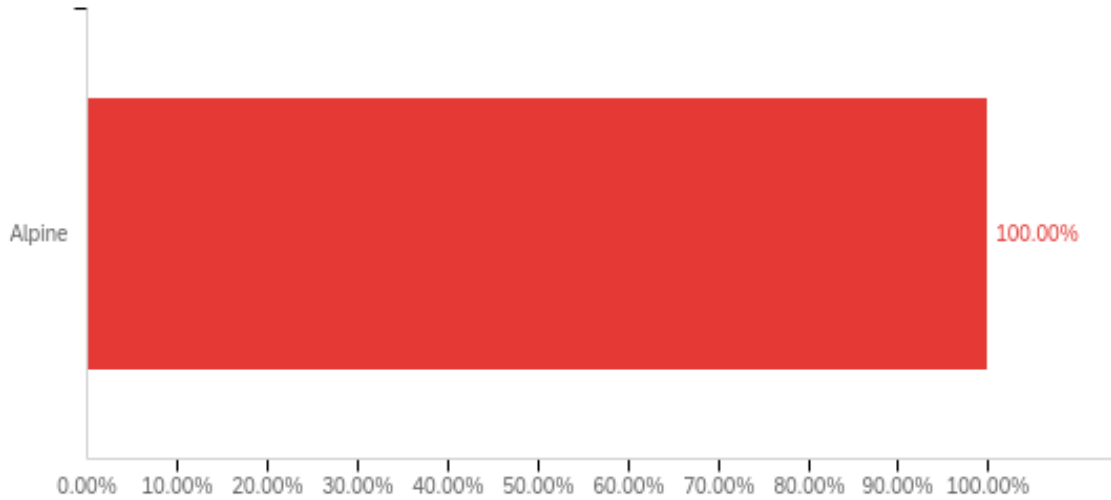

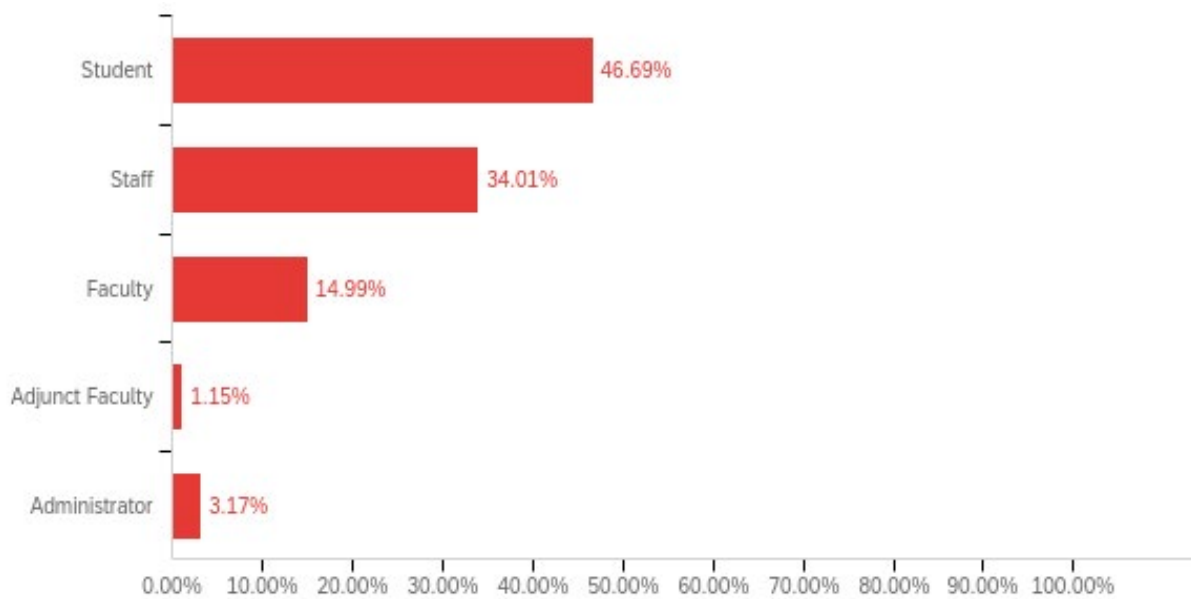

Q1 - What is your primary campus? (all)



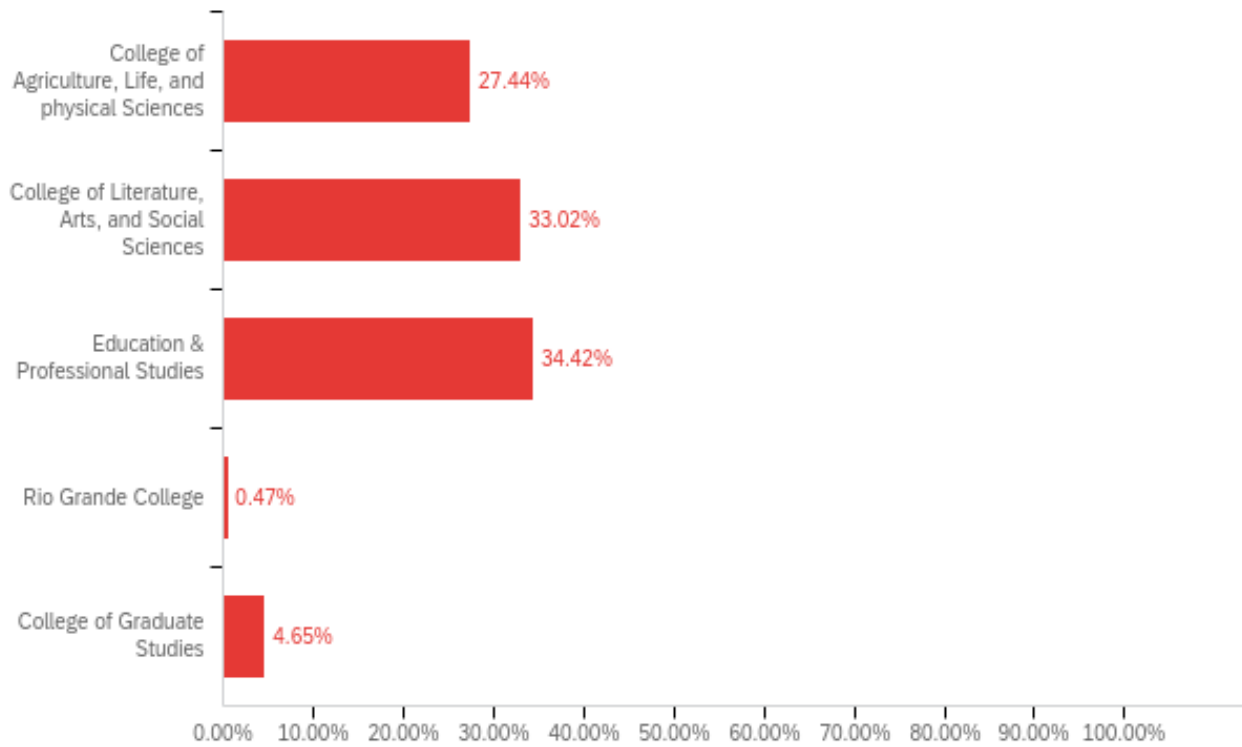

Q2 - What is your primary affiliation to SRSU? (all)



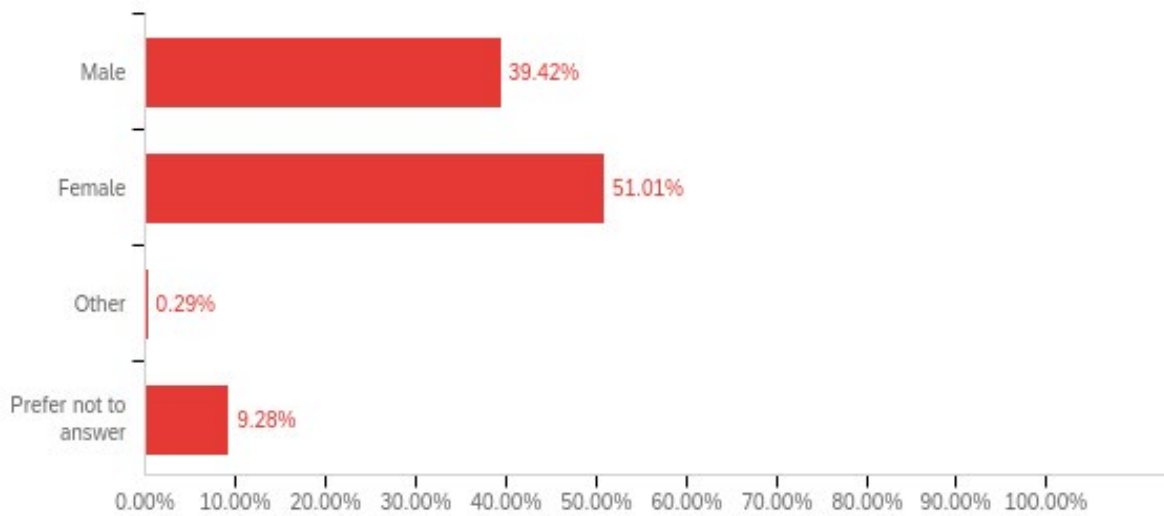

Q3 - With which college are you primarily associated? (all)



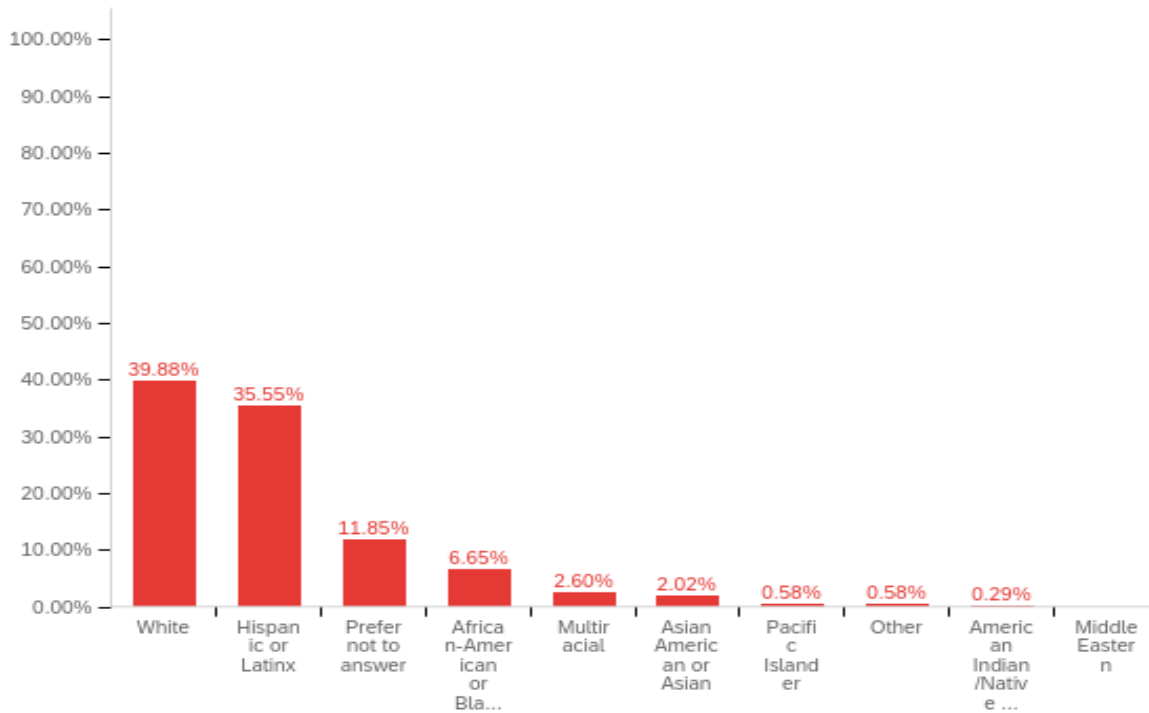

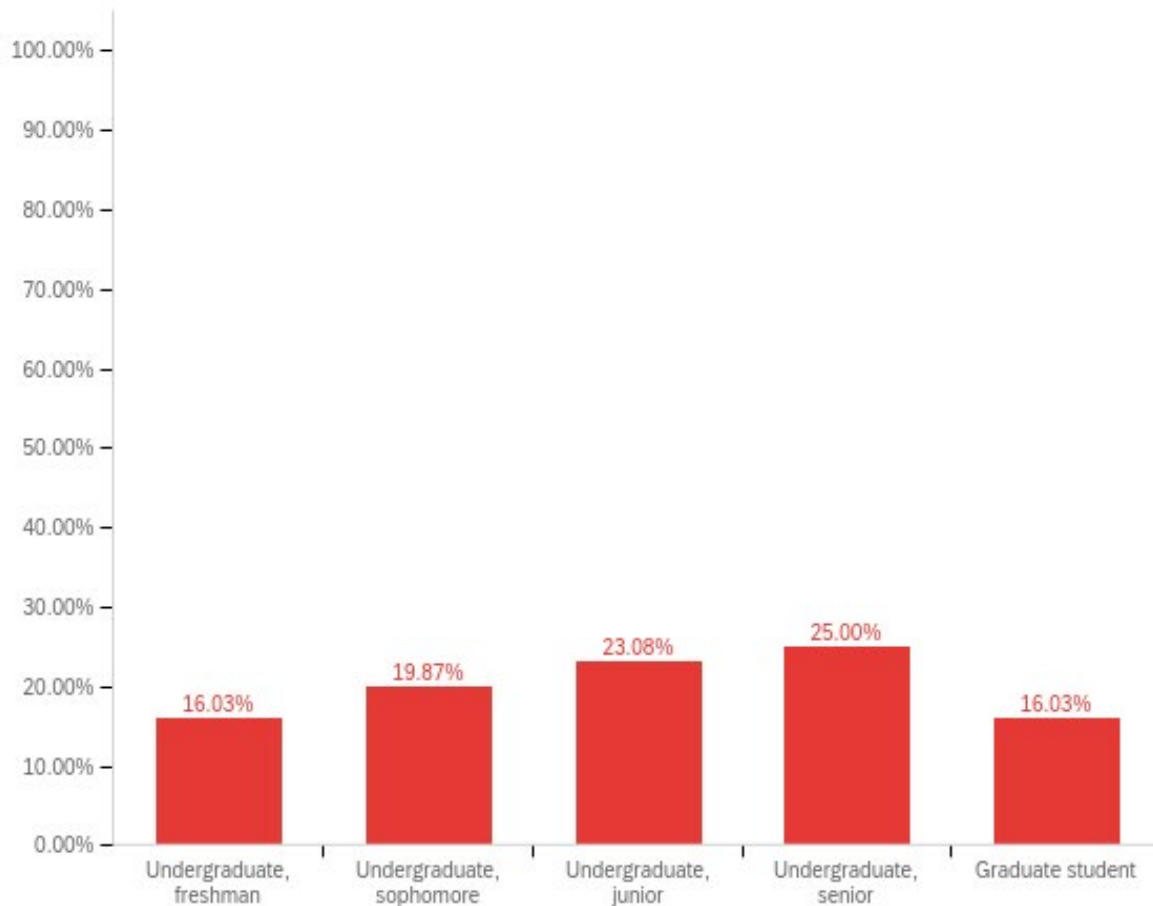

Q5 - Race or Ethnicity



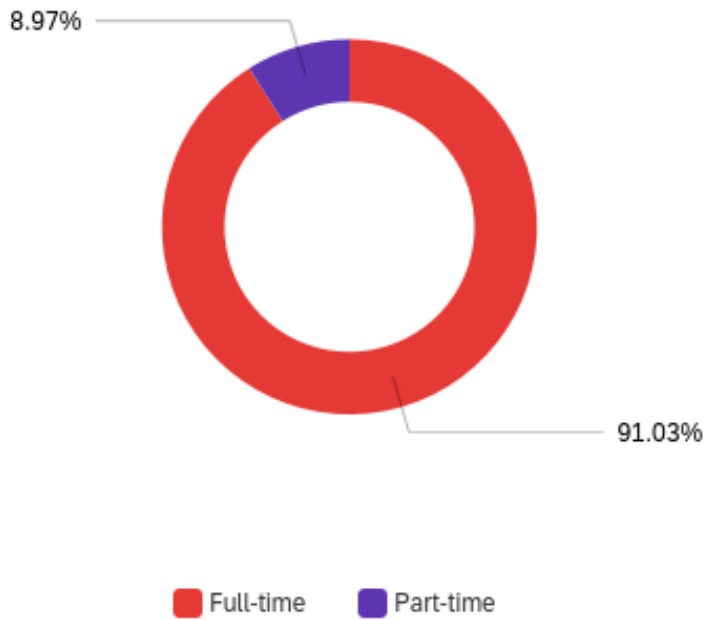

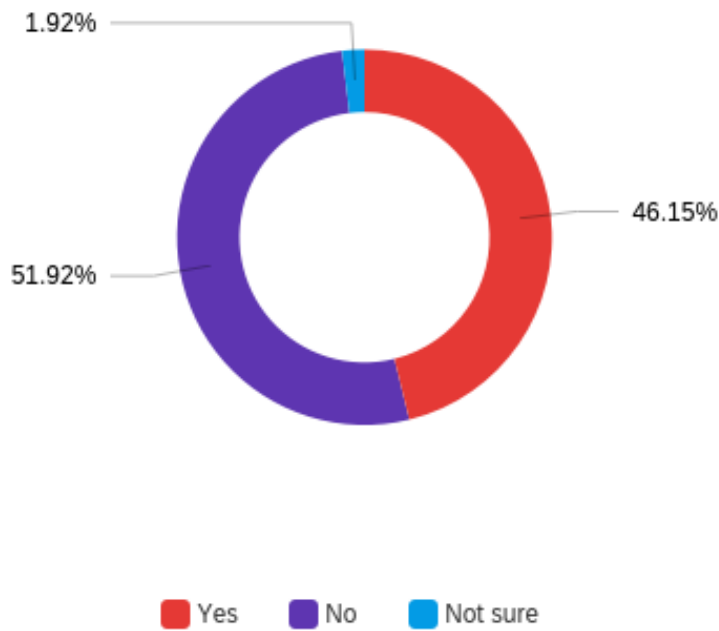

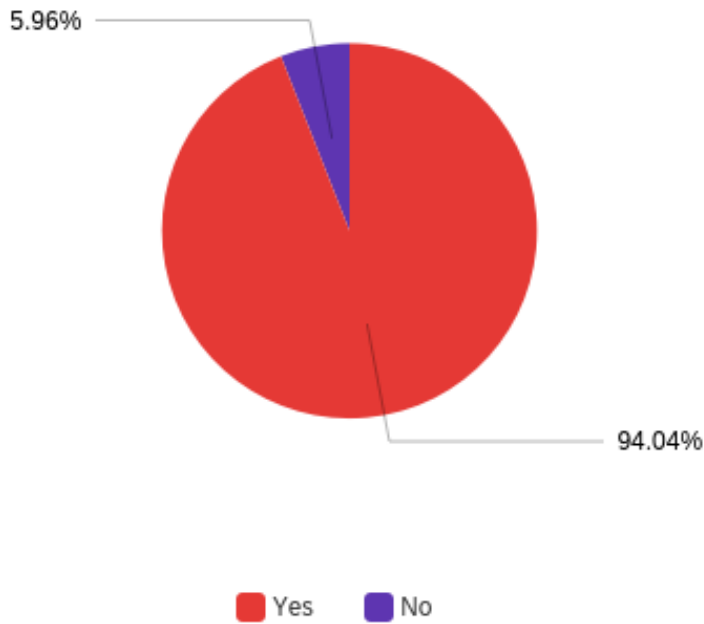

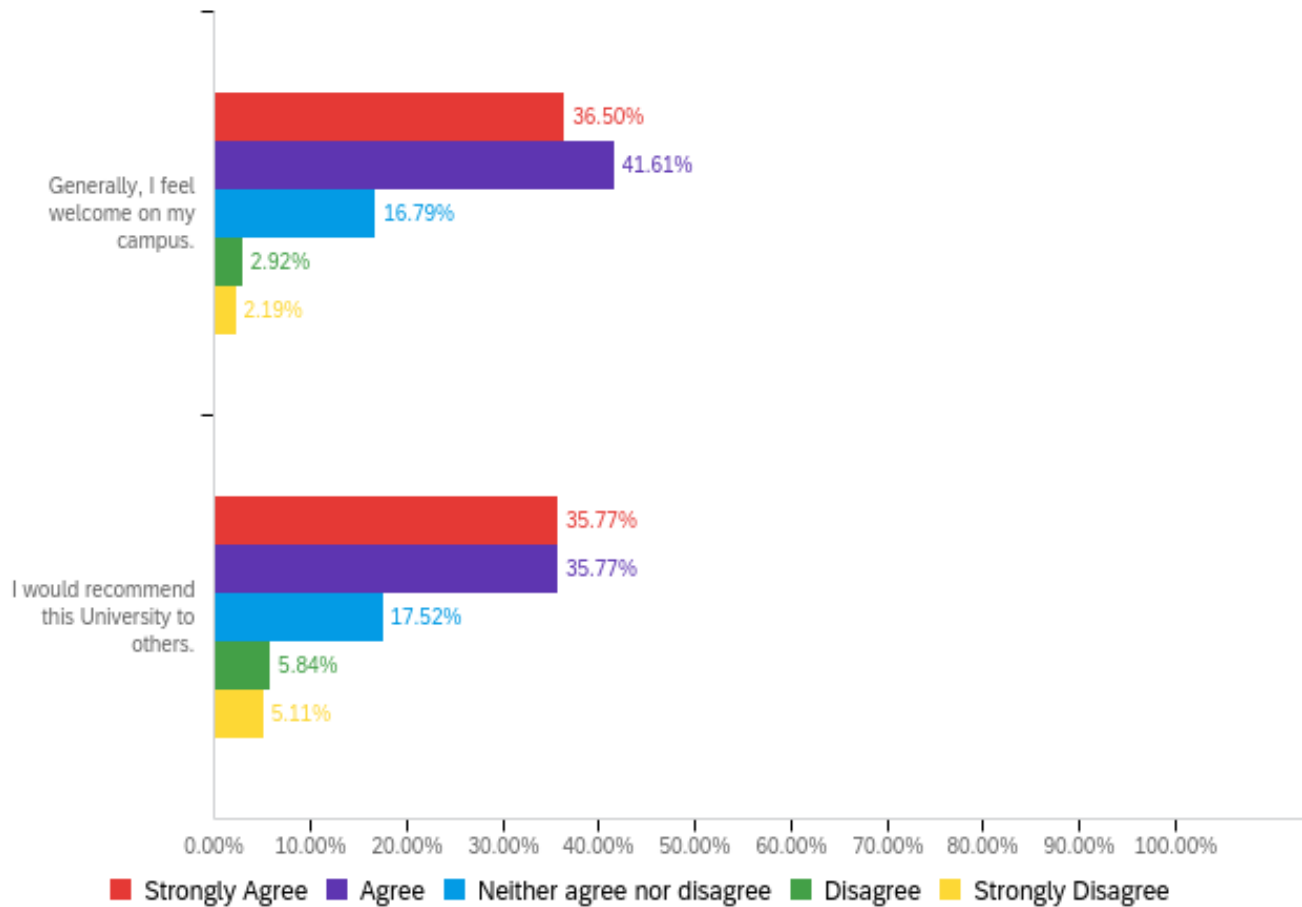

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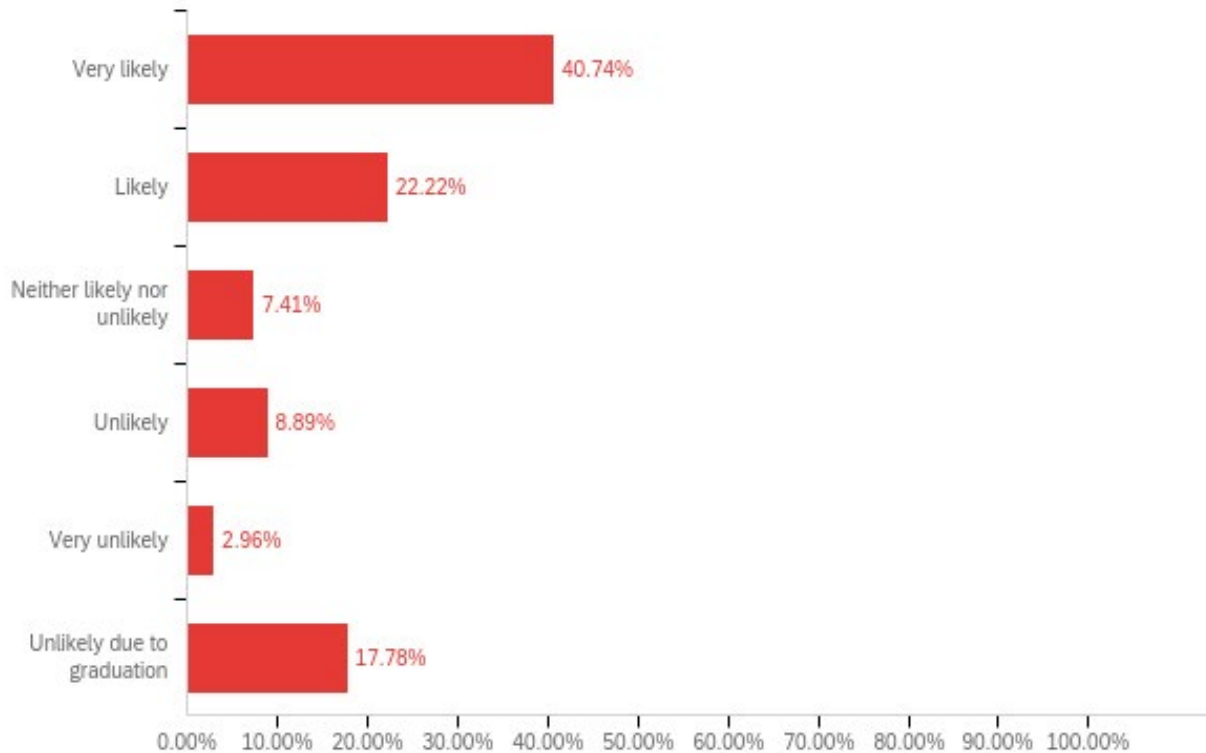

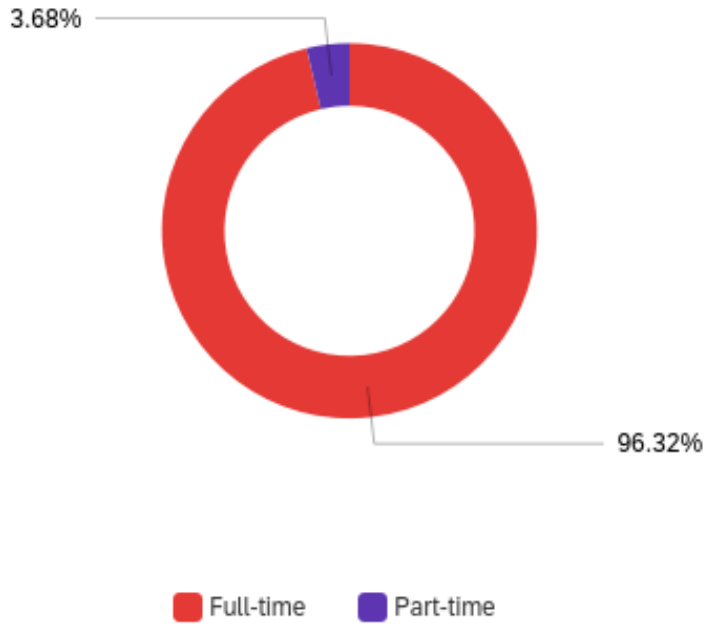
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Q16 - Is it likely you will be attending SRSU one year from now? (student)



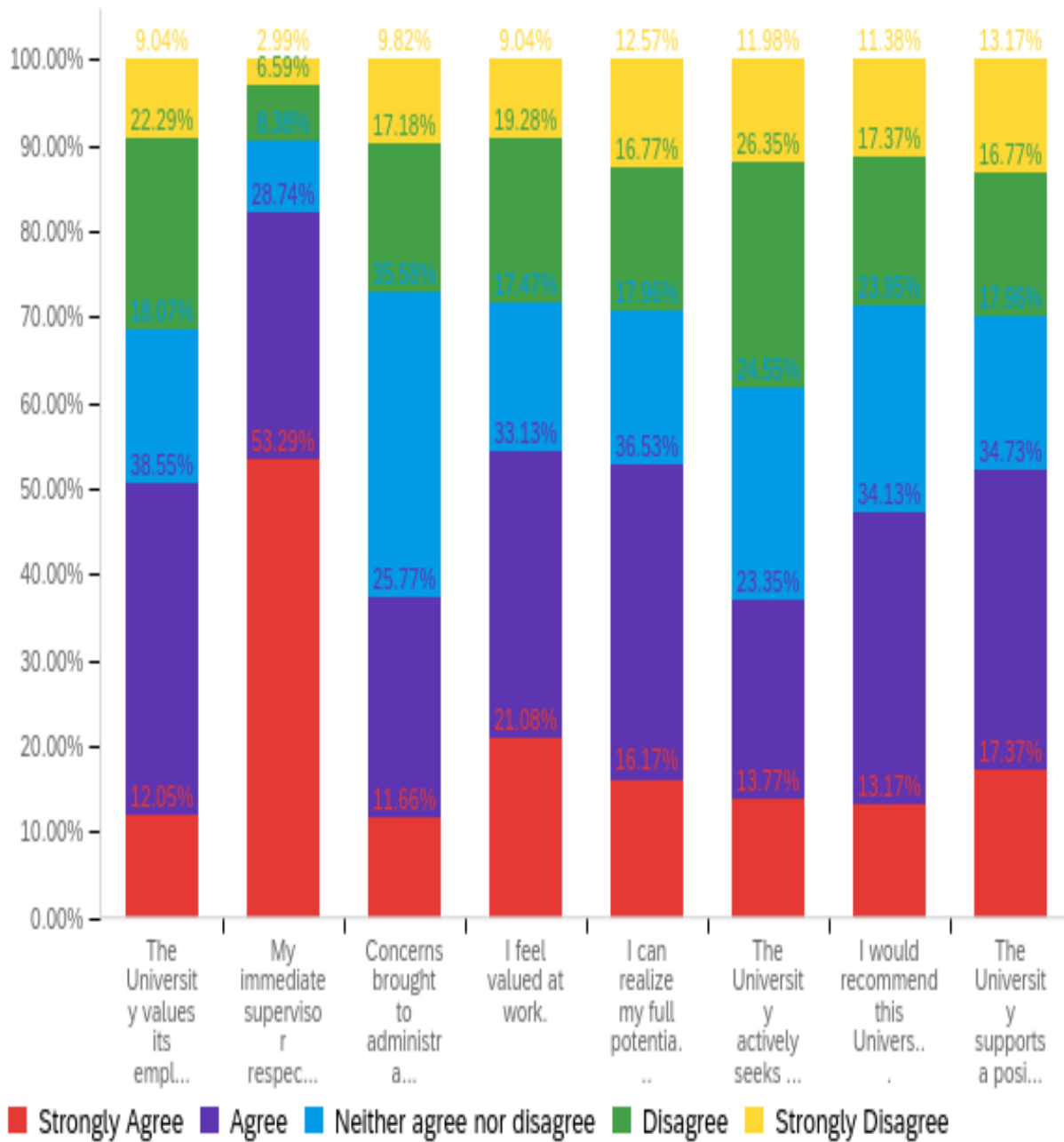

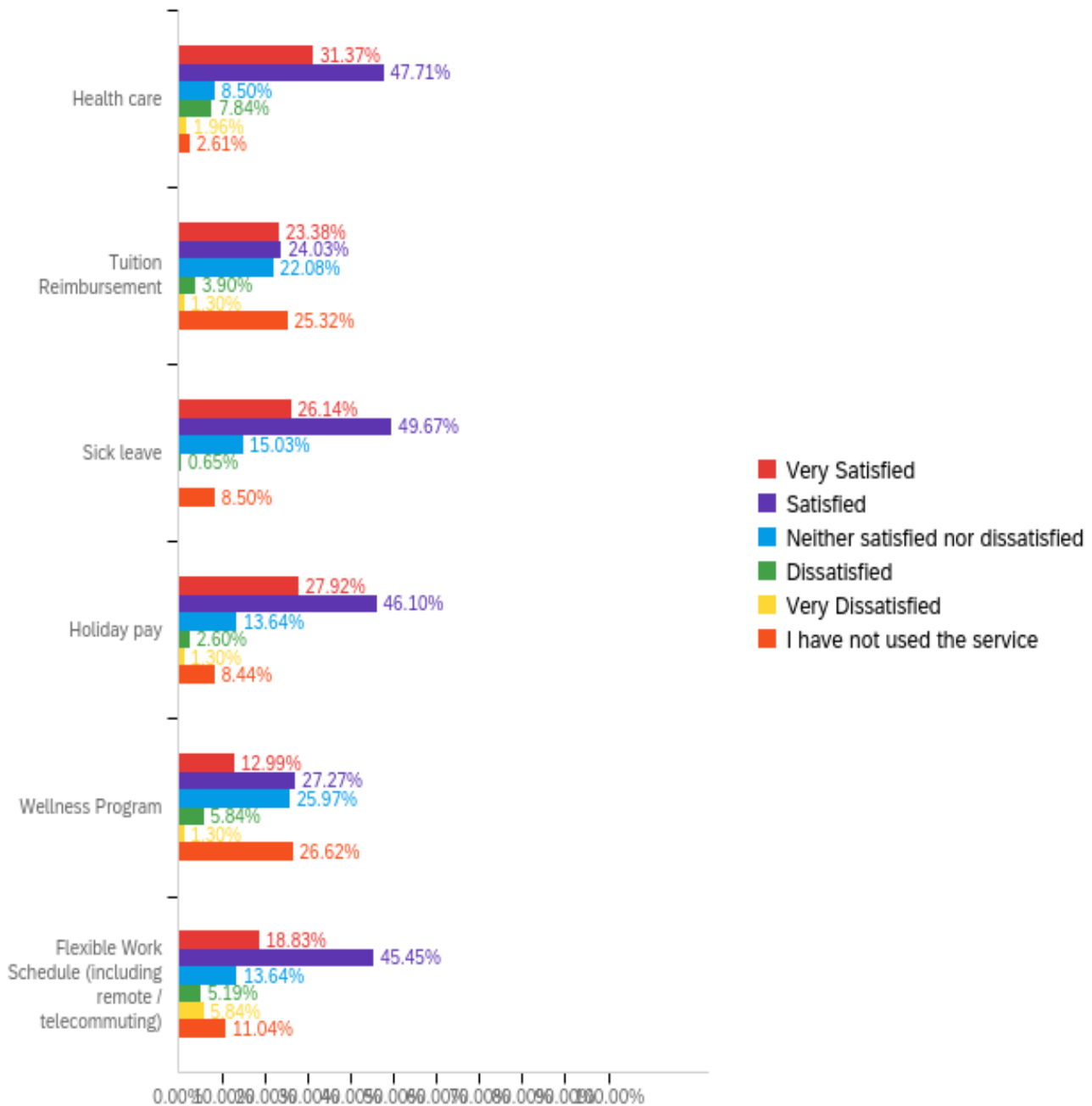

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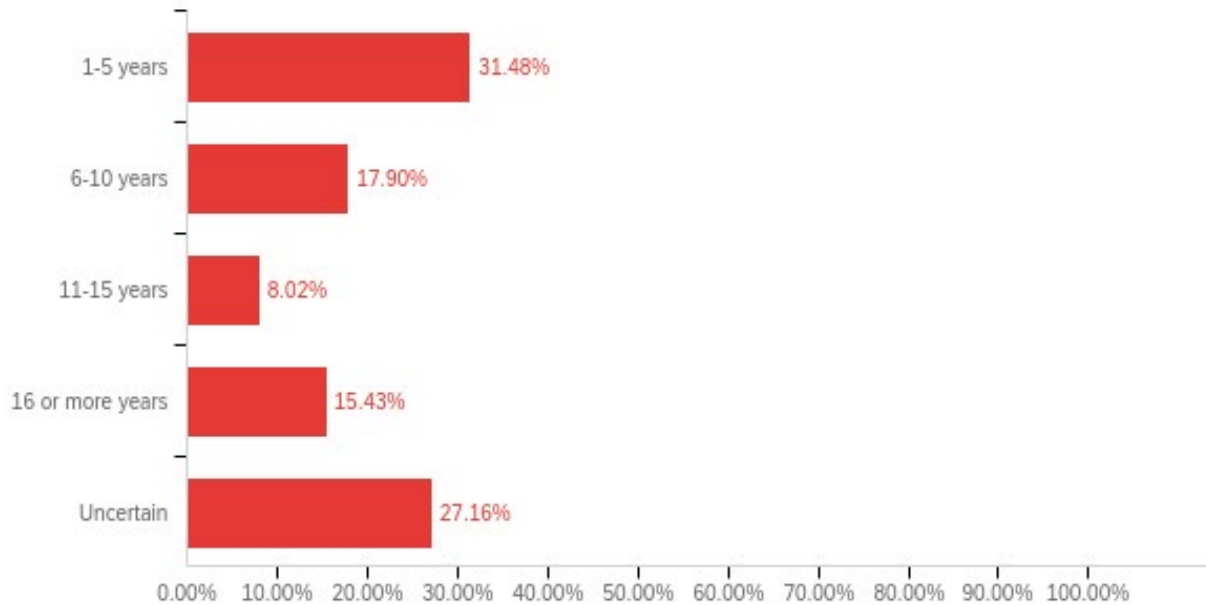

Q20 - How long do you anticipate working at SRSU? (faculty/staff)



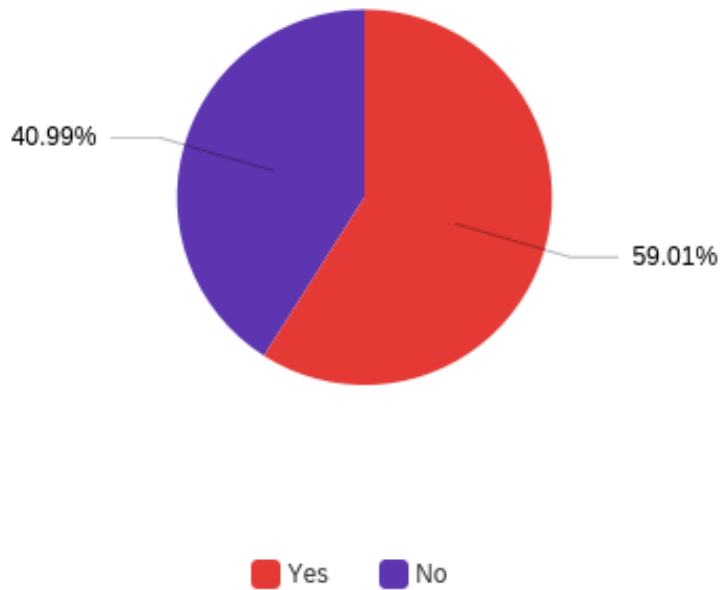

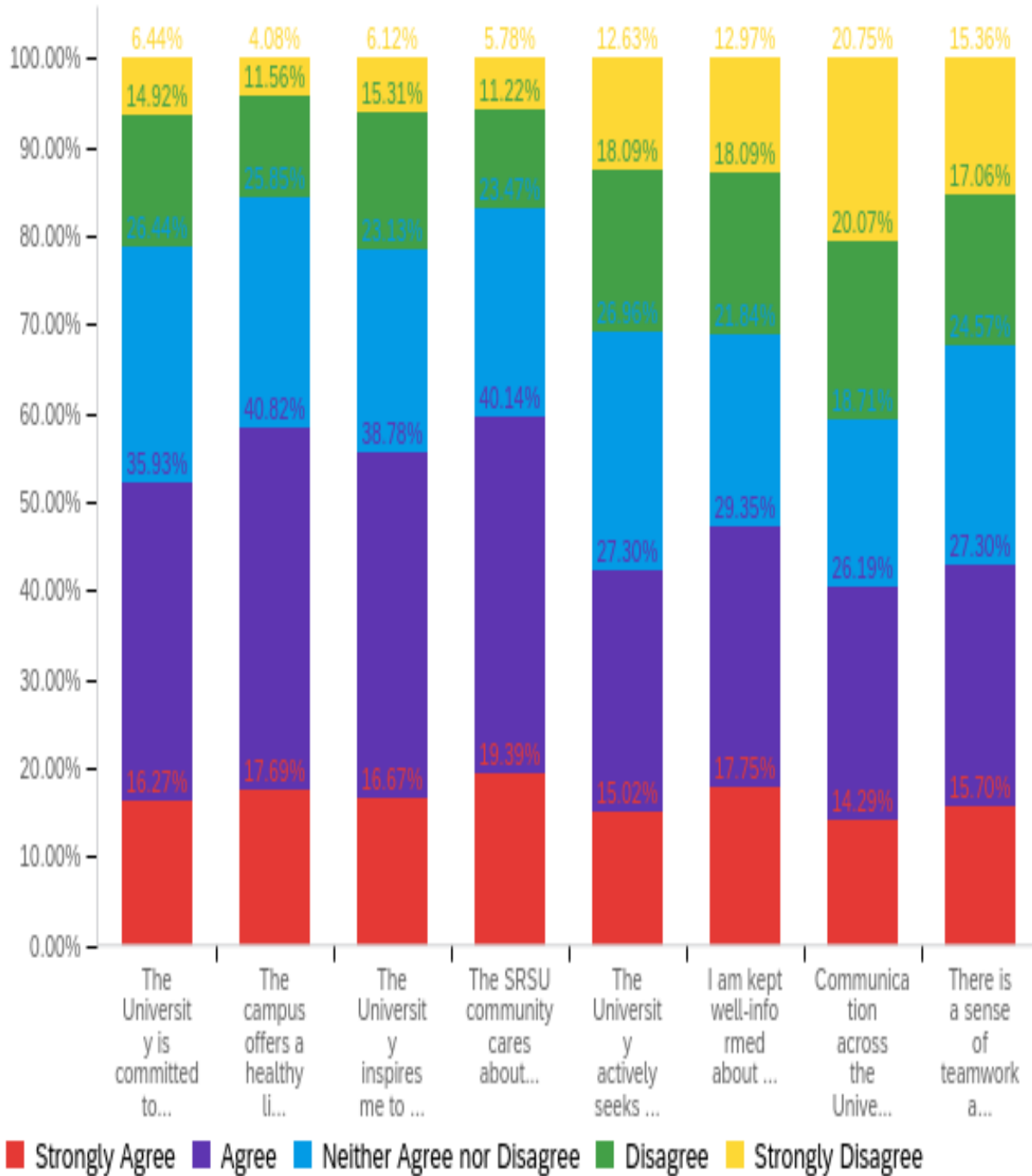

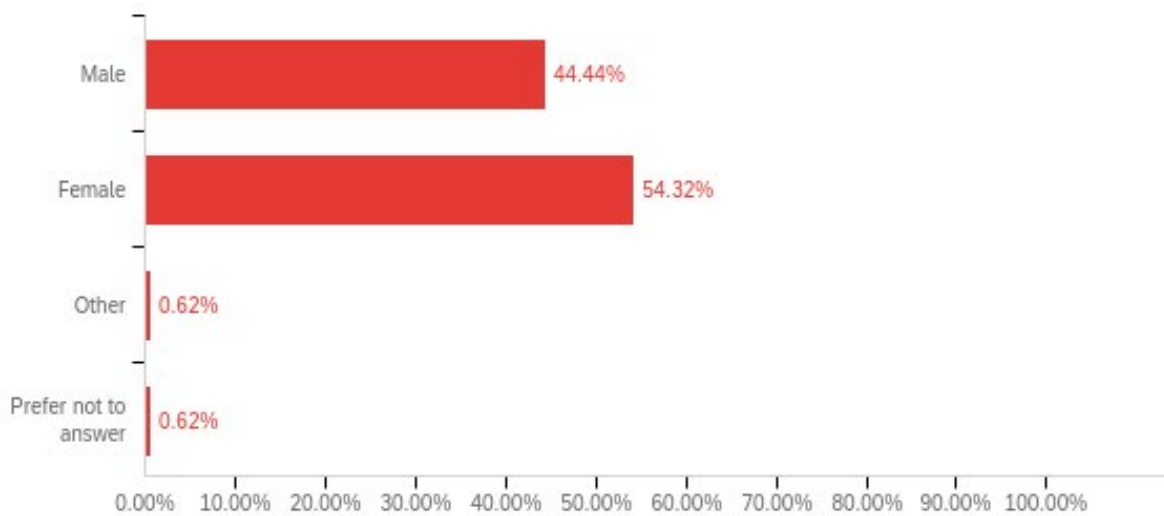

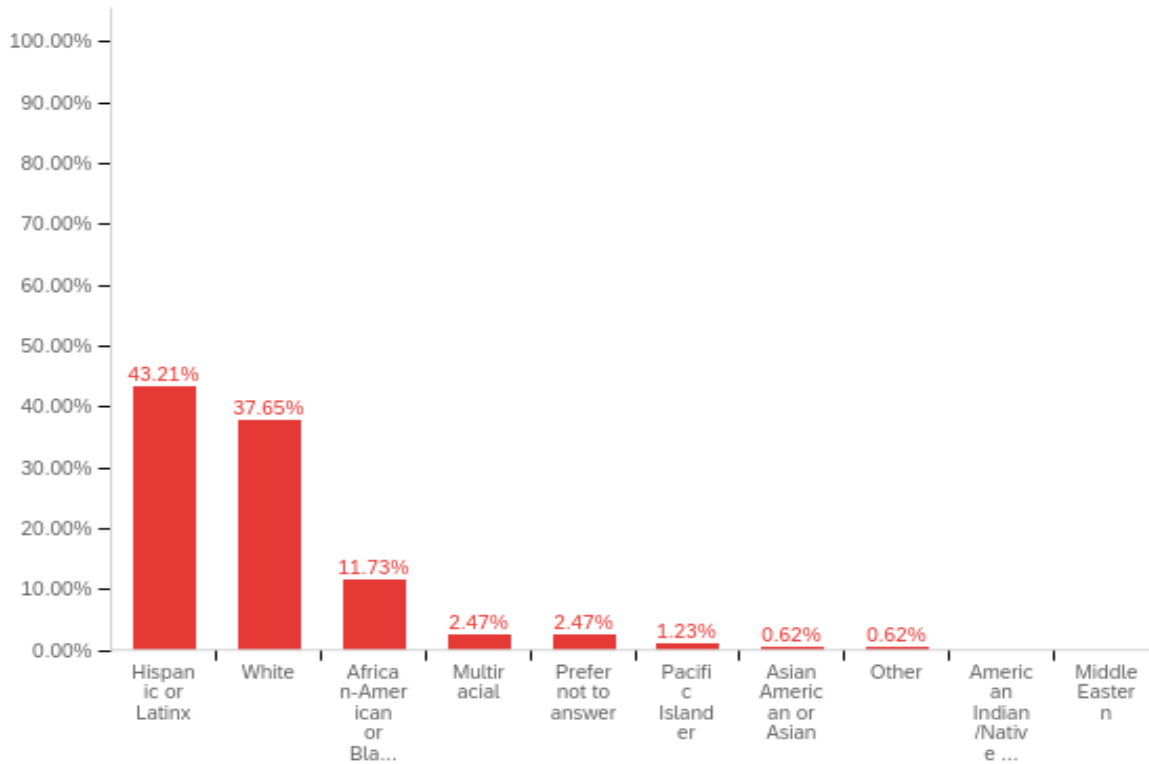

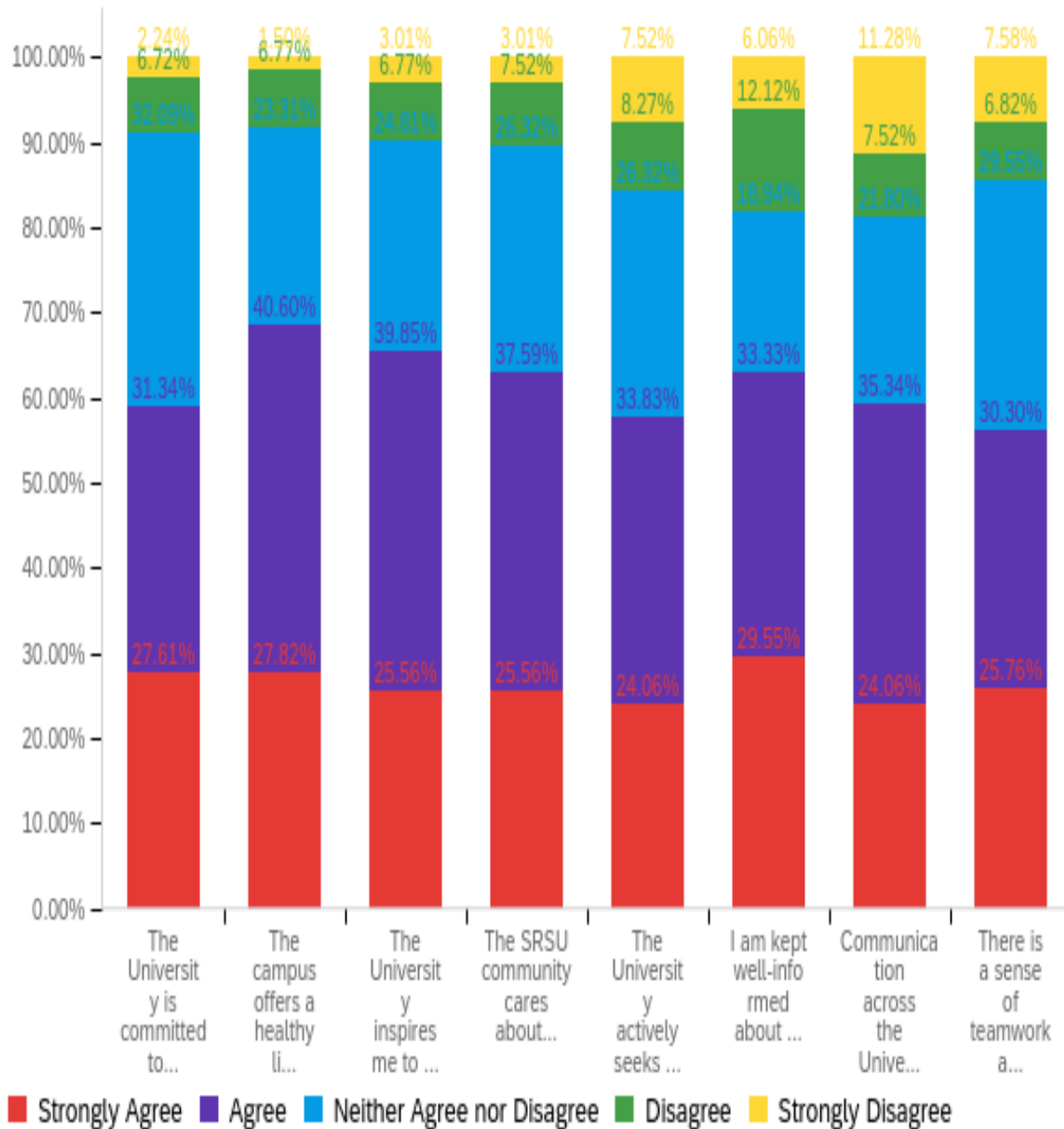

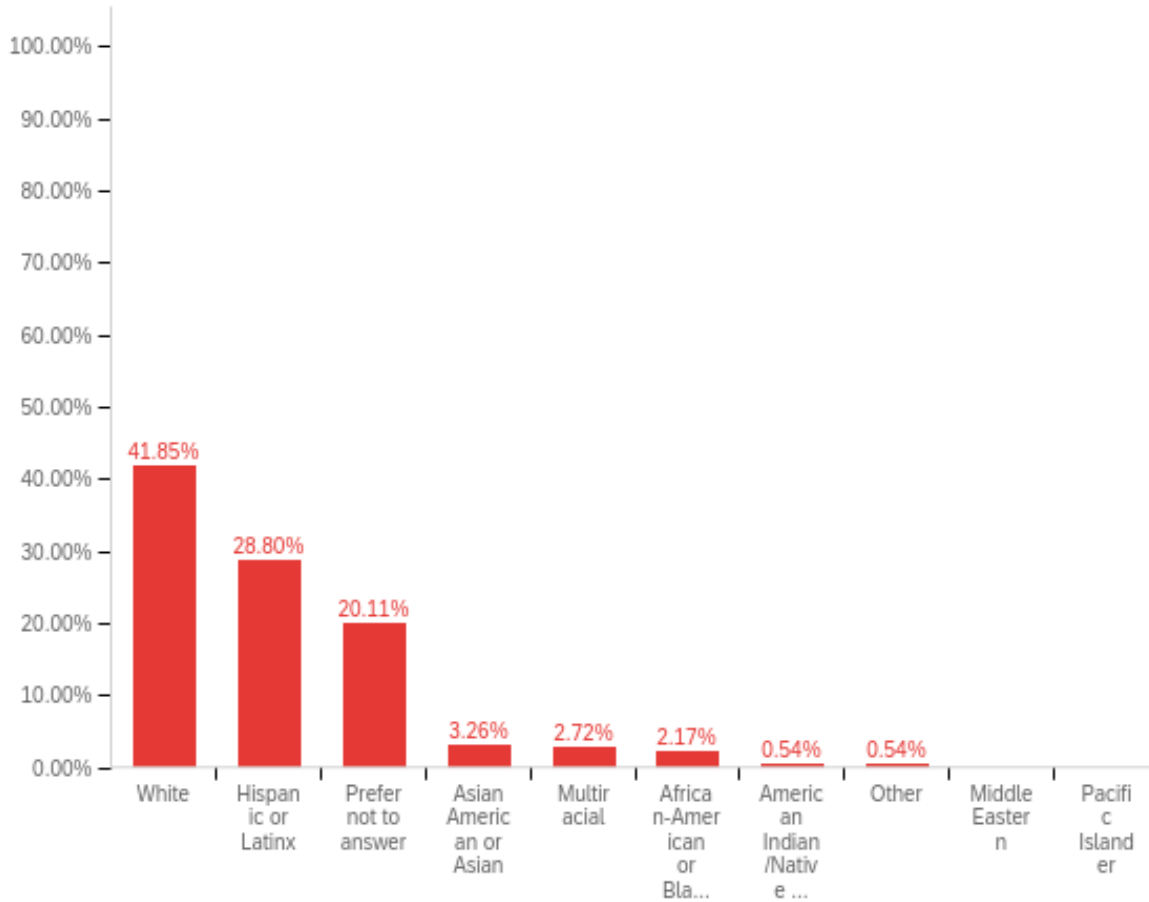

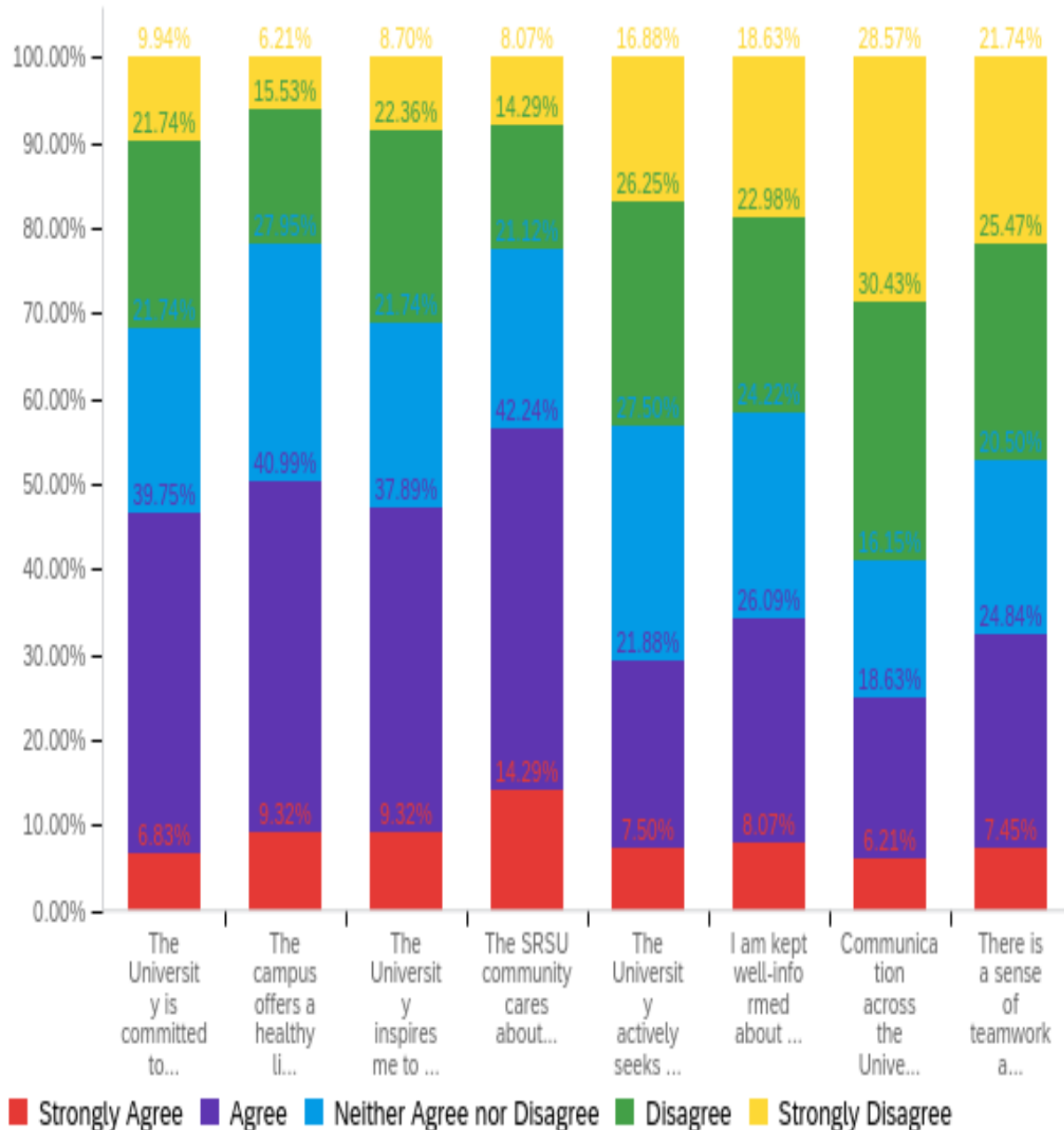

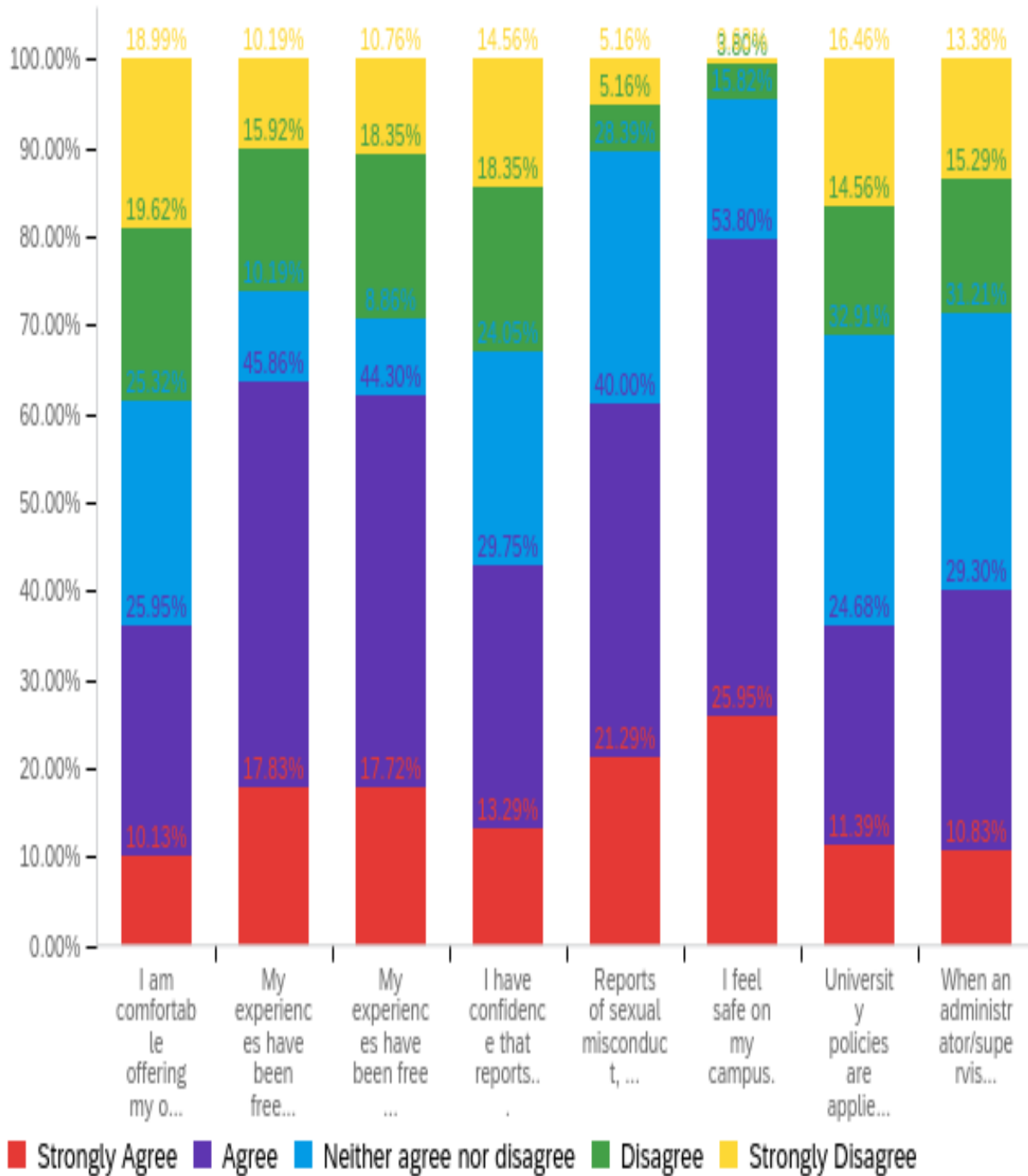

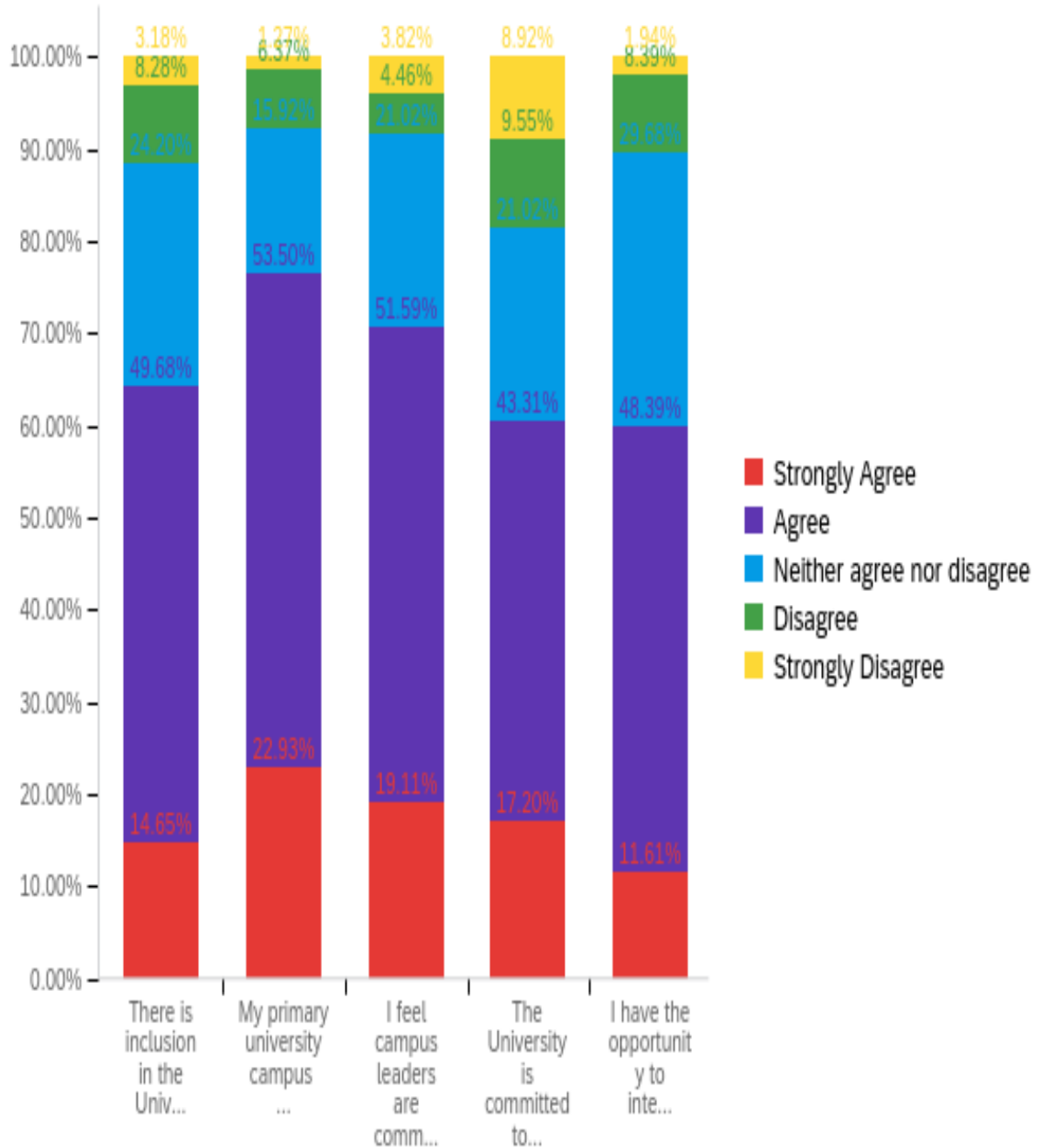
