





### Q6 - If you could start college over, would you choose to attend SRSU?





### Q7 - If you could start college over, would you choose to graduate with the same major?





# Q8 - How would you compare the quality of education provided at SRSU with that of other colleges/universities?











# Q12 - If you plan to pursue further formal education, how soon do you plan to pursue this additional education?











Q16 - For the program you are now completing, were any of the courses completed at another college/university? Did you transfer any major credits to SRSU?





### Q17 - On the average, how many hours per week did you study for each course you took?





### Q18 - Please include how often you used the computer lab




