LOBO PANTRY

The Lobo Pantry is a temporary, judgement free resource for students experiencing food insecurity. Students are eligible to visit the pantry once per month. The Lobo Pantry is located in Ferguson 108 and is managed by the Office of Civic Engagement & Student Assistance.

In Fall 2024, the Lobo Pantry had **613 visits** serving **333 unique individuals**. **41%** of those individuals have used the pantry more than once.





Produce

We offered 3 produce distributions for a total student participation of **384**. The largest engagement occurred with WTFB's Farmer's Market during the first week of the semester, engaging 245 students (64% of our total produce usage)


Lion's Club Donation

Growth & Changes



Monthly visits are down for Fall '24; however, produce engagement has increased. In addition, our overall clientele has increased by 254% since Fall '22, going from 94 users to 333 users of the Lobo Pantry.
